Q: What do you use to mend a jack-o-lantern?

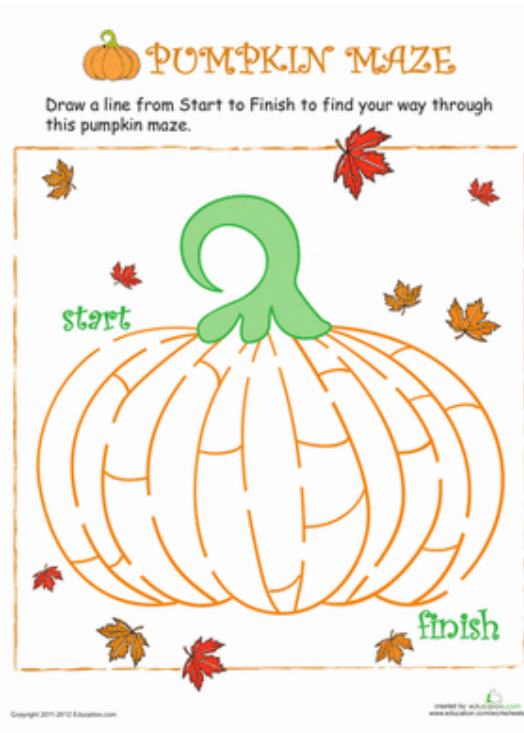

PWRDF RESPONSE TO HURRICANE

HARVEY/IRMA – Donations can be given to the PWRDF through our church or directly to Church House in Toronto marked "Hurricane Harvey/Irma".

Maintenance Fund: We continue to ask our parishioners to give monthly through the Maintenance Fund to help us lower our debt on the new furnace. We have borrowed the amount of \$50,000.00 from the Bank of Montreal. *This loan is out for seven years effective Dec. 31st, 2016, we are paying \$653.93 per month.*
